<u>Delta Airlines</u>: Your pet must be at least 10 weeks old for domestic travel and must fit in a small carry-on kennel that fits under the seat in front of you. Pets in-cabin will count as your one carry on item, but you are permitted to bring one personal item onboard the aircraft in addition. You can book a flight for yourself and your pet by calling (800-221-1212). The fee for taking your pet in-cabin is \$95 and can be paid at the ticket counter when you check in. <u>United Airlines</u>: Your pet must be at least eight weeks old and must fit in a small carry-on kennel that fits under the seat in front of you. You can book a flight for your self and your pet by calling (800-864-8331). The fee for taking your pet in-cabin is \$125 and can be paid at the ticket counter when you check in. Southwest Airlines: Allows small vaccinated dogs of all ages (documentation of vaccination not required) to travel with you in-cabin under the seat in front of you. All pets must be carried in an appropriate carrier. You can book a flight for yourself and your pet by calling (800-435-9792). Pets traveling are subject to a \$95 fee per pet carrier and can be paid at the ticket counter when you check in. Pet carriers are considered either a personal item or a carry-on item.
